METHODOLOGY

In our didactic proposal we are going to use active methodologies, which are the following ones:

- Cooperative learning: This method consists in students working in small groups with the aim of acquiring knowledge as a group, in this way they can contrast ideas, help each other, resolve doubts and develop teamwork skills. The teacher's job is to guide the process, solve group doubts and observe the learning process of the students.
- Project based learning: through different projects, students should be able to acquire knowledge about the biosphere and its diversity in a more dynamic and active way, being at all times aware of their individual and team development.
- Problem solving activities: students are presented with a problem related to climate change where they have to find solutions to make changes related to the situation they are presented with.
- Deductive reasoning: the main objective of this method is to go from more general information to details, for this, students will start with a general idea and from there they will have to develop different points and different alternatives.
