Carrying out this work on the Sierra de Arrigorrieta has been very enriching for the whole group, as it has made us learn more about the geography of Navarre and its biodiversity. Moreover, having to do it for children in the 3rd year of primary school has helped to give it a didactic approach, preparing activities according to their level so that they could learn more about their valley.

With this work we have managed to combine certain emotional and communicative aspects with elements of the natural environment. In addition, the activities propose a form of class outside the classroom, which brings the students closer to nature and their environment, achieving a greater connection with the work. The activities also allow for an internal reflection of the pupil, such as that of the diary, allowing for an internal reflection that is often lacking.

When it came to carrying out the work, we had many strong points, because from the communication in the group, we were able to organise ourselves quickly and in an orderly manner, agreeing on the points of the work to be carried out by each one and then, if necessary, transferring them to the Cmap. Moreover, if a colleague needed help or could not do his part, another colleague would help him, to help him. We were always in communication with each other to keep up to date on how the work was progressing.

In addition, at one point we lost everything we had done, having to start again from scratch everything we had advanced.
